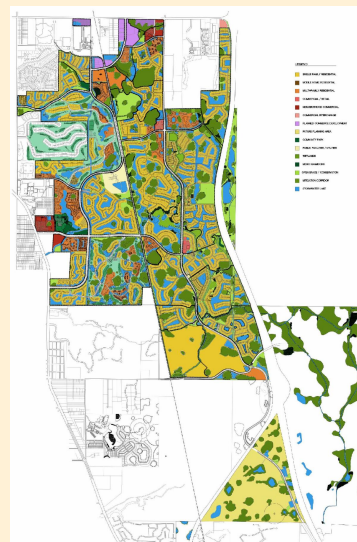

Communication from the Master Association to our Members

Turn Clocks Back This Sunday

This is a reminder that daylight saving time comes to an end at 2 am this Sunday, November 3rd when clocks will “fall back” to 1 am.



Hurricane Season 2024

While we were somewhat spoiled by the start of this year’s hurricane season, the latter half has proven to be quite stressful. Florida hasn’t seen this many storms make landfall in our state, in one season, in 20 years. The latest, Milton, made landfall on October 9th near Siesta Key, not far from Palmer Ranch, with sustained winds of 120 mph. In addition to the strong winds, there were concerns over flooding from storm surge and rain, thankfully neither of which occurred on the Ranch. Palmer Ranch has 3 rain gauges on the property, and we recorded 4” of rain.

While we had minimal damage to signage and fencing throughout the common areas, our greatest loss was to our landscaping. 20 Oak Trees, 5 Ligustrum Trees, 1 Sylvester Palm, and 1 Cabbage Palm were lost due to the high winds.

The Master Association budgets each year for operating contingency for events like hurricanes. Typically, these funds are used for labor to pick up debris and to facilitate repairs to our infrastructure. Given our common areas are County rights-of-way, debris removal is reimbursed to the County by FEMA. The pickup of the debris along the main roadways will take time. When Ian hit here two years ago, it took over 6 weeks for the debris piles to be removed. As an HOA, we weren’t eligible for FEMA reimbursement, so the Master Association Board chose to wait until the FEMA contractors picked up the debris instead of passing a special assessment to cover the cost to do it ourselves.

We do not foresee any special assessment in the future; however, we still have another a few weeks of hurricane season, and the meteorologists are indicating we’re not ‘out of the woods just yet.’

We’ll get through this, as we always do; however, it will take time. Just remember – we’re FLORIDA STRONG!

What does Deed Restricted mean?

All communities on Palmer Ranch, except for apartments, commercial and recreational entities, are Deed Restricted. Ok, so what is that? Deed Restricted means the community and thereby the home has restrictions in place that prohibit owners from taking certain actions. These actions are detailed in the community covenants and restrictions, which are enforced by the HOA. Routinely the restrictions will apply to exterior architectural changes to your home, maintenance of the common areas, parking, pets, landscaping, etc.. To be more specific and make it easier to understand, you may need approval from the community's Architectural Review Committee (ARC) before you do any/all the following:

- repaint your house
- change your landscape
- change your front doors, windows or reroof your home



These are just a few examples of what may need ARC approval, so be sure to check with the community association first! In most cases you might find this information on the community's website.

The purpose of these restrictions is to maintain a neighborhood's aesthetic and support property values.

Where are my property boundaries?

The Sarasota County Property Appraiser's website has a wealth of information, including a way to see your property's boundaries via Geographic Information Systems (GIS) software. While a survey is always the most reliable option, this website is nearly as accurate.

- Click on PROPERTY SEARCH
- Begin entering the address of the property and look for it to appear on the list below. Once located, select the address and press SEARCH.
- You'll see the details of the property, including the sales history.
- To view the property boundaries, click on MAP. (This is especially helpful as many homeowners believe they've a large yard with their property, only to find out that large area may be a Preservation Area belonging to the community.)
